Boundary Change

In December 2021 with the agreement of Pettistree Parish Council, Wickham Market Parish Council started a petition to move the southern boundary to include the Wickham Gate Development being built by Hopkins Homes. One hundred and thirty-six new homes contributing to Wickham Market through their council tax yearly, plus a community infrastructure levy (CIL) from the developers payable to East Suffolk Council who then distribute a portion to the Parish to fund community projects.

With the community governance review 2021 to 2022 the request for a boundary change was approved and put in place from the 1st April 2023.

Welcome Wickham Gate into our community.

Quiet Lanes

Now that I am back from my holidays the signage for wave 3 and 4 will be collected and installed on posts erected by Highways.
